Start with an unforgettable hook

This is your book's headline - and it's crucial.

Those first few seconds are what reel people in.

Make them count...





Introduce the main character(s)

Introduce who the reader will be following.

Focus on their goal, challenge or personality.

Pique the reader's curiosity...







Highlight the central conflict

What's at stake?

That's why your reader should care.

Add tension and urgency...







Tease, don't tell

What will the reader want to know?

"Will the character succeed?"
"Will the relationship survive?"
"Will they solve the mystery?"

Leave these questions unanswered...







End with a call-to-action

What should the reader do next?

"Read the book to find out what happens."
